

To be an Apprentice Welder (depending on work site/contractor) you will require a full Canadian Welding Bureau Qualification.

To be qualified you require an Alberta Apprentice card. If you do not have a government issued apprentice card than you need to register with the Alberta Government at the Advanced Education office. The ironworkers can accept your apprenticeship contract and you can continue your training program for welding through the 720 hall.

Although the 720 hall doesn't get a lot of calls for apprentice welders you are still eligible for work as long as you have been a registered welder apprentice, if you are currently a welder apprentice or if you have a valid contract. The contract doesn't have to be with one of the 720's signatory contractors, but they will be willing to train you through work experience.

You do not have to have your Red Seal ticket if you are a registered apprentice.
